Agenda Item #4: Communications Plan Update Ms. Sorrick reviewed the current Communications Plan with the Committee members. Agenda Item #5: Social Media Update Ms. Okuma provided statistical data regarding public access to Board information via Facebook, Twitter and Webcast. Dr. Gallardo requested that future meeting packages include current and prior statistical data.

Agenda Item #6: Website Update

 Ms. Okuma provided statistical data regarding the five top views of the Board's website.

Dr. Gallardo commented that he and Ms. Sorrick discussed the possibility of conducting a Website Survey to help improve access to information contained within the Board's website.

Dr. Immoos commented she supports the idea of the Board conducting a survey regarding its website as many of her staffs have expressed difficulty locating information on the site. She also stated that cross-referencing information on the site would be helpful.

Agenda Item #7: Update on Newsletter

A copy of the Board's Fall 2015 Journal was provided to the Committee members. Ms. Sorrick reported the Winter Journal is scheduled to be published in March 2016.

Agenda Item #8: Outreach Activities Update

Ms. Sorrick reported the following outreach activity for the current fiscal year:

• Stakeholder meeting at the State Capitol to discuss SB 479 on August 18, 2015.

- Dr. Horn and Ms. Johnson will attend the upcoming California Psychological Association convention as guest speakers discussing licensing issues.
 - Ms. Sorrick has been invited to speak at the Association of State and Provincial Psychology Boards' meeting in Anchorage Alaska. The request is pending approval.
 - Board members and staff will be delivering informational packets to Senate Business, Professions and Economic Development committee and staff members in February, including an invitation to attend the Board's February 2016 meeting that will be held in the State Capital.

- Health Professions Education Foundation (HPEF) presentation on the loan repayment program at the August 13-14 Board meeting
- Feature story in Summer Journal regarding a recipient of the loan repayment from the Foundation
- HPEF recipient profile in future Journals
- Insert for license renewals and other mailings to explain how licensees can access HPEF loan repayment funds, and how they can contribute to the fund.

Agenda Item #10: Discussion and Potential Recommendation to Full board Regarding Outreach to High Schools to Increase Licensing Population - Access to Care

Ms. Acquaye-Baddoo expressed interest in the Board reaching out to high schools and community colleges to help students identify and meet career goals to becoming a psychologist.
