SUBJECT	Agenda Item 7 - Enforcement Report

Please find attached the Overview of Enforcement Activity conveying complaint, investigation, and discipline statistics to date for the current fiscal year.

The Board has hired Barbara Tanner, prior Board Probation Monitor, as its new Special Investigator effective November 7, 2016. Ms. Tanner will be responsible for investigating the most complex cases, collecting arrest and conviction documents, interviewing witnesses, and testifying at hearings. With the hiring of Ms. Tanner, there will be one vacancy in the Enforcement Unit. The Enforcement Program Manager will be working with the Department of Consumer Affairs' Office of Human Resources to fill the vacancy by the end of the calendar year.

Complaint Program

Since July 1, 2016, the Board has received 363 complaints and 10 criminal conviction reports. All complaints received are opened and assigned within eight (8) days of receipt.

As reported in the August Enforcement Report, the Board began referring most cases to the Division of Investigation (DoI) in July in order for formal investigations to be completed within 12 months. The Enforcement Manager is meeting quarterly with DoI representatives to discuss the processing of cases. Board staff is continuing to monitor their cases handled by the Health Quality Investigative Unit (HQIU).

Citation Program

Since July 1, 2016, the Board has issued 12 enforcement citations. Citation and fines are issued for minor violations that do not require formal discipline. For example, false or misleading advertising and minor record keeping violations are considered minor violations.

Discipline Program

Since July 1, 2016, the Board has referred 18 cases to the Office of the Attorney General for formal discipline. The Executive Officer and the Enforcement Program Manager are meeting quarterly with Senior Assistant Attorney, General Gloria Castro, to discuss procedures and the handling of cases.

Probation Program

Enforcement staff is currently monitoring 52 probationers. Of the 52 probationers, no one is out of compliance. Currently there are 40 probationers in a tolled status.
