SUBJECT	Agenda Item #7 (a)(ii)(AA) – SB 215 (Beall) Inmates: Victim Advocates	

Background:

This bill would require a state prison or a county jail to provide inmates with reasonable access to outside victim advocates for emotional support services related to sexual abuse, domestic violence, and suicide prevention by allowing inmates to call the toll-free hotlines of organizations that provide mental health crisis support. The bill would also specify that reasonable communication between an inmate and those organizations is confidential and require that calls to the toll-free hotlines are free of cost to inmates.
