<b>SUBJECT</b>	Agenda Item #7 (a)(iii)(H) – AB 835 (Dababneh) Consumer Affairs

**Background:**

This bill would make nonsubstantive changes to existing law which provide that it is a misdemeanor for any person to, among other things, fail or refuse to surrender to the issuing authority upon its lawful written demand any license, registration, or certificate that has been suspended, revoked, or canceled.
