| SUBJECT | Agenda Item #6(c)(37) – SB 27 (Morrell) Professions and Vocations: Licenses: Military Service. |

Background:

This bill would require every board within the Department of Consumer Affairs to grant a fee waiver for the application for and the issuance of an initial license for applicants who supply to the board satisfactory evidence that the applicant has served as an active duty member of the California National Guard or the United States Armed Forces and was honorably discharged. The bill would require that a veteran be granted only one fee waiver, unless the board charges a fee for the application for a license and another fee for the issuance of a license.
