<b>SUBJECT</b>	Agenda Item #16(b)(2)(UU) – SB 575 (Leyva) Patient Access to Health Records

**Background:**

This bill would require health care providers to provide patients with free access to medical records needed for applications or appeals of denials for benefits under specified public benefit programs. This bill would expand the list of public benefit programs to include In-Home Supportive Service programs, the California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CaWORKS) program, CalFresh, and federal veterans' service-connected compensations and non-service connected pension disability benefits.
