SUBJECT	Agenda Item #7 (a)(ii)(G) – AB 349 (McCarty) Department of Consumer Affairs: Licensure Applicants

Background:

This bill, on and after July 1, 2018, would require a board within the Department of Consumer Affairs to expedite, and would authorize a board to assist with, the initial licensure process for an applicant who supplies satisfactory evidence to the board that the applicant was issued a specified special immigrant visa. Additionally, the bill would require boards to accept a special immigrant visa case number for licensure application purposes.
