

<b>SUBJECT</b>	Agenda Item #7 (a)(ii)(Q) – AB 704 (Grayson) Multidisciplinary Teams: Human Trafficking

**Background:**

This bill would authorize a county to establish a domestic violence multidisciplinary personnel team and a human trafficking multidisciplinary personnel team to allow agencies to share confidential information in order to investigate reports of suspected crimes. This bill would also authorize members of those multidisciplinary personnel teams to disclose to one another information and records that are relevant to the prevention, identification, or treatment of those crimes. These teams may include psychiatrists, psychologists, marriage and family therapists, or other trained counseling personnel.
