SUBJECT	Agenda Item #7 (a)(ii)(R) – AB 720 (Eggman) Inmates: Psychiatric Medication: Informed Consent

Background:

This bill would replace the term “a person sentenced to imprisonment” to “an inmate confined”. This bill would also define an “inmate” to mean a person confined in the county jail, including, but not limited to, a person sentenced to imprisonment in a county jail, a person housed in a county jail during or awaiting trial proceedings, a person who has been booked into a county jail and is awaiting arraignment, transfer, or release, and an intoxicated person who is being held in a county jail until sober.
