## **Background:**

This bill would authorize any person who assisted the United States military and was issued a specified special immigrant visa to be ranked in the top of the resulting eligibility list if he or she achieves a passing score on an entrance examination in the State's civil service hiring process.

This bill previously would have required boards to expedite processing of and assist individuals with completion of their initial application for licensure if they had a specified special immigrant visa.
