SUBJECT	Agenda Item #16(b)(2)(AA) – AB 827 (Rubio) – Department of Consumer Affairs: Task Force: Foreign-Trained Professionals

Background:

This bill would establish the California Opportunity Act of 2017. This Act would require the Department of Consumer Affairs to create a task force to study and conduct reports on the licensing of foreign-trained professionals into the state's workforce. These reports must include strategies to integrate foreign-trained professionals along with methods to implement the strategies. The reports are also required to identify any state and national licensing regulations that potentially pose unnecessary barriers for foreigntrained professionals as well as identifying the best practices to integrate foreign-trained professionals into the workforce in other states.
