| SUBJECT | Agenda Item #21(b)(2)(C) – AB 1893 (Maienschein) Maternal Mental Health: Federal Funding |

Background:

Current law requires the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) to develop and maintain a statewide perinatal service program to ensure the appropriate level of maternal, newborn, and pediatric care is provided for the mother and infant. AB 1893 (Maienschein) would require the Department to investigate and apply for federal funding opportunities regarding maternal mental health for their service program. This bill also would require CDPH to notify the Legislature on or before January 1, 2020 regarding how it plans to secure and use the federal funding received.
